Primary 1 parents

On the first day please feel free to come in with your child to drop them off in the morning. Our gate opens at 8.45am and Mrs. Wain will be waiting in the classroom to get everyone settled and organised! We know this can be a big moment but we would encourage you to make your goodbyes short and sweet! At the end of the day, Mrs. Wain will bring them down to the bottom of the driveway and hand them over to their grown up. After this, please drop your child off at the school gate each day.

Keeping our children safe

As part of our Health and Safety Risk Assessment, our playground gates will now be locked at 9am and will be re-opened at the end of the day. Anyone arriving after 9am, will need to report to the School Office Entrance. Any visitors or parents who are picking up during the school day must come to the School Office Entrance. This will also have an impact on those returning from home lunch: a member of staff will be able to open the gate at 12.15 to allow them to go home. However, if they wish to return before 1pm, they MUST report to the School Office Entrance so that we can ensure they are marked as returned.

Keeping all of our children safe is our most important job and this is why we have made these changes. If you would like to discuss this in any more detail then please get in touch.



Punctuality

Could we ask all of our parents and carers to work with us to make sure that our

children are arriving on time for school? We open our doors from **8.45am** and the school day begins officially at **9am**. As we do our soft start, the learning begins the minute our children come through the door, so being on time is very important.

Ipay Impact

Can all SCHOOL parents make sure that they have logged in and pre-ordered children's lunches. Can you log in and mark on the system EVEN IF they are a packed lunch or home lunch. The new menu has already been issued and is available to view on the Ipay Impact website. All children in ELC and P1 to P5 are entitled to a free school meal. Our ELC parents will mark their meal choice on the sign-in sheet as normal each morning. If you are having any issues with the system please let us know and we will be happy to help.

Data Check Forms

These will be issued tomorrow and we would ask that you read them carefully, check all of the details are still correct and return them by Friday at the latest. In particular, please remember to sign and date them! The information you provide is used to keep in touch with you and it is especially important in an emergency. Can all parents and carers ensure that they are keeping the information we hold on you up to date throughout the year? Thank you so much for your support with this.

Collection at the end of the school day

Please note that all children in Primaries 1 to 3 must be collected by an adult at 3pm. We know that circumstances changes so if there are any last minute changes to the adult who is collecting could you please let the school know as soon as possible? Pupils in Primaries 4 to 7 may walk home themselves.

Also, please observe the parking regulations when you are dropping off and picking up! Our school gate is very busy and there is no school crossing patroller so it is important that we all work together to keep our children safe.

There will be no PE this week for our classes. We will send our our PE timetable by the end of the week. Please remember that on PE days our children should wear our PE uniform which is:

White polo shirt/t shirt

Blue school jumper/blue PE hoodie

Black jogging bottoms/leggings/shorts

We would really appreciate your support with this, and staff will be reinforcing this expectation on every PE day.

ELC Arrangements

The ELC will run from 8.45 until 2.45 each day.

Children are provided with a hot meal at lunchtime each day and the menu has been sent to you.

Snack is always fruit and milk which we encourage the children to serve themselves.

At pick up and drop off there might be a bit more queuing as we are trying a new system, so only two adults at a time will be able to access the foyer. We will see how it goes and make changes if we need to.

Please don't send your child in their best clothes! They are likely to get pretty mucky as we are out in all weathers.

Can you let us know if your child is going to be off or you are running a bit late so that we can make sure our registers are updated and we are ordering the correct number of lunches. Thank you!
